BYLAW 29/89

THE MANITOBA DENTAL ASSOCIATION

MULTIPLE PRESCRIPTION PROGRAM

A Bylaw to improve efforts to prevent and detect controlled substance abuse and diversion in conjunction with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba, the Manitoba Pharmaceutical Association, the Manitoba Dental Association and the Manitoba Veterinary Association.

With the Agreement of the previously mentioned organizations. . .

BE IT RESOLVED THAT, beginning on January 1st, 1990, a multiple prescription is required from a prescriber, in order that a pharmacist may fill a prescription for the designated drugs listed on the attached Appendix.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the multiple prescription for these drugs, be issued and dispensed according to the policies and procedures agreed to and amended from time to time, by the aforementioned organizations.
